

53rd Philadelphia Better-Ball Championship

Fri., Sat. & Sun., June 12, 13 & 14, 2020 Cobbs Creek GC Managed by the PPGA



Eligibility: Entries are open to all amateur golfers, regardless of handicap and club affiliation. Entries are subject to approval or rejection any time (either before or during the Championship) by the PPGA Championship Committee. The Committee decisions shall be final in all rulings. To be eligible to compete in the senior division both players must be 50 years of age or older on or before June 12, 2020. The senior division will be contested Saturday and Sunday, June 12 & 13.

Exemptions: John Buliga & Dom Foti, 2019 Champions, Carlos Ochoa and Ed Kahn, 2019 Senior Champions

Entrance Fees: The entry fee is \$300.00 per team or \$220 for the senior division (**greens fees and range balls are included in your entry fee**). The entry fee for teams to participate in both is \$360 per team. **NO** refunds will be granted for cancellations received after the closing date.

Entries close June 1, 2020 in the Association office. No entries will be accepted after the deadline.

Pairings and Tee Times: Pairings and starting times will be determined by the Executive Committee for the first day of play and contestants will be notified by e-mail when they are available on the PPGA website, www.phillypublinks.com. Players will be repaired for the final two rounds and the tournament will be flighted based on score after the first round. All contestants should check-in at the first tee 10 minutes before their tee-time. A contestant who fails to appear for his tee time and has not canceled his entry by written or verbal notification to the Association office may be subject to disqualification for this event and subsequent events of the Association.

Competition: Friday's round will serve as the qualifying round for flights in the 53rd Philadelphia Better-Ball Championship. The championship flight will be the top 16 teams and will be contested in a match play format. All other flights will be stroke play format. The senior division will be contested over 36 holes to be played Saturday and Sunday and flighted for Sunday's final round if the size of the field permits. There will also be a Super Senior division (60 and above) if there are enough entrants.

Gift Certificates will be awarded to the top teams in each flight.
