

48th Phila. Open Amateur Championship

Fri., Sat. & Sun, July 17, 18 & 19, 2020 Cobbs Creek Golf Club Managed by the PPGA



Eligibility: Entries are open to all amateur golfers, regardless of handicap and club affiliation. Entries are subject to approval or rejection anytime (either before or during the Championship) by the PPGA Championship Committee. The Committee decisions shall be final in all rulings. Players participating in the senior division must be 50 years of age on or before July 17, 2020.

Exemption: Caleb Ryan, 2019 Champion and Chris Fieger, Sr., 2019 Senior Champion

Entrance Fees: The entry fee for the Open Amateur is \$150.00 or \$110 to participate in the Senior division (greens fees and range balls are included in your entry). The entry fee for players that wish to play both divisions is \$180. NO refunds will be granted for cancellations received after the closing date.

Entries close July 7, 2020 in the Association office. No entries will be accepted after the deadline.

Pairings and Tee Times: Pairings and tee times will be determined for the first round by the executive committee and contestants will be notified by email when they are available on the PPGA website, www.phillypublinks.com, at least one week prior to the start of the tournament. Players will be repaired for the final round only. All contestants should checkin at least 10 minutes before their tee-time at the first tee. A contestant who has not canceled his entry by written or verbal notification to the Association office may be subject to disqualification for this event and subsequent events of the Association.

Competition: The Open Amateur Championship will be played over 54 holes of stroke play. The senior division will be contested over 36 holes to be played Friday and Saturday and flighted for Saturday if the size of the field permits. There will also be a Super Senior division (60 and above) if there are enough entrants

There is no cut and the field will be flighted after the 1st round.

In the event of a tie for the lowest score in any flight, a sudden-death playoff will be held following the conclusion of play, all other ties will be broken by the USGA method. The Awards presentation will begin immediately following the conclusion of play. Gift Certificates will be awarded to at least the top 3 places in each flight depending on the size of the field.
