

PPGA Match Play Championship

Qualifying - May 10, 11, or 29, 2025 Turtle Creek Golf Club



Eligibility: Entries are open to all amateur golfers, regardless of handicap or golf club. Entries are subject to approval or rejection anytime by the PPGA Championship Committee. The Committee decisions shall be final in all rulings. The Senior Match Play Championship is open to all golfers 50 years of age or older on or before May 16, 2025. The Super-Senior Match Play Championship is open to all golfers 60 years of age or older on or before May 16, 2025.

Exemptions: Connor Vanin, 2024 Champion, Luis Diaz, 2024 Senior Champion, Howard Press, 2024 Super-Senior Champion

Entrance Fees: If you are registered to play in the PPGA Better-Ball or PPGA Senior Better-Ball Championship, the entry fee is \$30 for any division, \$55 to compete in two, or \$80 for all three. If you are not registered and you are just playing to qualify for the Match Play Championship on Monday or Thursday, the entry fee is \$80 (**greens fees and range balls included**). If you wish to qualify on Saturday or Sunday, submit the entry fee of \$30 and you will be required to pay the applicable greens fees at the course. Walking is permitted. No refunds will be granted for cancellations received after the closing date.

Entries close May 2, 2025 in the association office. No entries will be accepted after the deadline. Entries for championship will be extended until May 18, 2025 due to the rescheduling of the Better-Ball Championship.

Pairings and Starting Times: All contestants should check-in at their starting tee 10 minutes before their starting time. A contestant who has not canceled his entry by written or verbal notification to the association office may be subject to disqualification for this event and subsequent events of the association. Starting times will be posted to the website www.phillypublinks.com and contestants will be notified by e-mail one week prior to the event.

Competition: The PPGA Match Play Championship will be played with qualifying at Turtle Creek GC on EITHER May 10, 11, or 16 to determine seeding. Competitors can choose one of those days to qualify. Matches will then be 18 holes of match play with sudden death format if the match is all-square after 18 holes. Matches are to be played at the choice course of the higher seed within a given time period. Dates will be finalized and posted to the PPGA website along with official rules of competition. All players are guaranteed at least one match as everyone who turns in an 18-hole score will be seeded in the match play bracket. Failure to turn-in an 18-hole qualifying score will result in disqualification.

Gift Certificates will be awarded to the top finishers depending on the size of the field.
